Blue Ring Campaign

Woodridge Native Launches The Blue Ring Campaign, a Positive and Affordable Ocean Conservation Initiative

Woodridge native Alex Rose is far beyond her 30 years when it comes to ocean exploration. As an underwater photographer, science editor, managing editor, PADI Divemaster, Explorers Club Fellow and professional violinist, she's traveled to the Galapagos, Cuba, Norway and the Arctic in support of her mission to enhance public understanding of the marine world and to find ways to protect the ocean realm through research, writing, conservation and education.



When you talk to her mentors or some of the prestigious scientists that Alex works and travels with, they would not only rave about her exceptional dedication to conservation, but also her violin playing. She has impressed her peers (including her mentor Dr. Sylvia Earle, the world-renowned oceanographer) with keynote presentations and talks on sustainability while also attending and speaking at Singapore's Ocean Week ADEX in April.

On June 8th - World Ocean Day, Alex will launch the Blue Ring campaign.

The idea began when she tried to create a personal Facebook page for "The Ocean." Alex felt a "in a relationship" status would reflect her dedication and passion to protecting the world's precious marine habitats. However, due to Facebook rules and restriction, Alex settled for a public figure page of the same name (www.facebook.com/thoughtsfromtheocean).

But it wasn't until she gave a keynote presentation at the 2016 Blue Ocean Film Festival that she discovered her mission. A woman in the audience approached her after her talk and it was clear she was emotionally moved by the imagery Alex displayed from her Arctic expedition. The woman explained, "If I ever get married, that's where I would want to do it. But I don't want to marry a person, I want to marry the ocean!" Alex knew what she had to do...use that sentiment to catalyze some serious change in the world.



The Blue Ring campaign is a positive and affordable ocean conservation initiative where anyone over 18 years of age can Mery™(marry) the Ocean. (derived from the root word "mer" meaning sea). For a membership fee of \$25 annually, people can show their ongoing and committed relationship with the Ocean and contribute to the conversation and become part of a global network. Participants will receive a digital Meriage Certificate along with a ring made from recycled ocean plastic. Anyone under age 18, for a membership fee of \$10 can be adopted by the ocean and

become a "child of the sea." Instead of a ring to showcase their commitment, they will receive a pin made from recycled ocean plastic. The first year's goal is to raise \$5 million dollars for two-1000 meter, dual-classed submersibles to be used by world renowned oceanographer/explorer Dr. Sylvia Earle to continuous ocean exploration. www.bluering.blue

RENDEZVOUS WITH LITTLE BLUE

I recently read an article making a case for why you should not be afraid of ordering wines made with grapes that you may have not heard of, or produced in countries that aren't considered "mainstream" for wine. With over 10,000 varieties of grapes, and wine production in almost every country, chances are there are some gems out there that you've never heard of, let alone had an opportunity to try. When you're at a restaurant or just walking through the aisles of your favorite liquor store, roll the dice once in a while and grab a bottle of something new to you!

Recently, I had an absolute gem from Croatia named "Little Blue" after the grape's appearance. Interestingly, Croatia is an expert in wine making. Wine production has been attributed to the ancient Greek settlers, arriving on the Croatian coast in the 5th century BC. In other words, Croatians have been making juice a lot longer than we have in the states.

I tasted "Little Blue" by Zlatan Otok Vineyards from Dalmatia, Croatia. On the islands and the Dalmatian coast, local grape varying microclimates, and the rather harsh nature of the vineyards, leads to some highly individual wines and some of Croatia's best known. Little Blue is made with 100% Plavac Mali (Plah-vatz mah-lee) which is a cross between Crljenak Kaštelanski (Zinfandel) & Dobričić grapes – indigenous to Croatia.

This charming and super affordable wine has notes of black raspberry, tobacco, white pepper, smoke, dried fruit, and a hint of prune. Little Blue is a fun light-hearted wine which will be my 2017 #SummerJam for sure! Re-



Hot zones include all cooking spaces, such as the grill, pizza oven and cooktops. Cold zones are made up of refrigeration and freezers. Wet zones are comprised of sinks and adjacent workspace. Dry zones are prep counters and storage.

A truly effective outdoor kitchen involves all four zones working together. Planning ahead can make prepping, cooking, serving and cleaning go more smoothly.



For example, the cold zone should be located next to the wet zone. This can make moving food from the refrigerator to the sink to wash much easier before going to the grill.

Landing Space

When you're cooking, you need space at each workstation to set things down. One of the most frequent outdoor kitchen design shortcomings is insufficient counter space.

Ideally, you should have open countertop space to each side of a sink, grill, cooktop and every other workstation. These open spaces are called landing zones.

Outside the Lines

As homeowners want to spend more time in their outdoor kitchens, storage space is becoming increasingly important. At the very least, they will want to store cooking items like wood chips, charcoal, grilling gloves and brushes in outdoor cabinets for the season

Many homeowners want a fully functional outdoor kitchen that operates independently from the indoor kitchen, which requires even more storage space to keep pots, pans, utensils and cutting boards outside.

Outdoor cabinetry needs to be ready to withstand the elements. To handle rain and keep items dry, weather-tight options are available.

WORLD VISION GLOBAL 6K FOR WATER

I don't know about you, but I love water. It's truly my favorite drink — with wine coming in as a very close second. I drink water all day, and I love it best when it is ice cold. In our community, or heck, in most of our country, access

to clean healthy water is literally a faucet turn or bottle cap twist away. Although, our friends in Flint, Michigan might disagree with me. However, in developing countries around the world, nearly 1,000 children under the age of five die each day from diseases caused by contaminated water, poor sanitation and improper hygiene.

Chicagoan Rusty Funk, the National Director of Team World Vision, has, for the last three years, been leading the charge in organizing and running the Global 6K for Water here in Chicagoland. World Vision is a humanitarian organization that provides long-term solutions to poverty, emergency assistance and advocates on behalf of the poor. They are the largest non-governmental provider of clean water in the developing world and currently work in 100 countries. The Global 6K for Water is an opportunity for local communities to help bring clean water to children around the world.

This year, the event was held on May 6th, and it was the first year they rolled out on a national and global scale having more than 27,000 participants from 18 countries. The course, 6K (about 3.7 miles) is the average distance people (often women or young girls) in developing countries walk daily to get water. Many times, that water is dirty. Every \$50 race registration provided

clean water to one person.

This year, nearly 1.6 million dollars was raised

for clean water projects. Each participant that ran or walked the course wore a bib with a picture of a child in need of assistance. Many families, at the lose of the event.
