Doodia caudata: Small rasp fern

Family: Blechnaceae

Genus: Doodia named after Samuel Doody an

apothecary of London.

Species: *caudata* from the Latin *caudatus* (with a tail) in reference to the drawn-out terminal lobe.

This is a terrestrial fern growing to about 20cm. The leaflets are leathery and dull with serrated edges. It grows in tropical and subtropical rainforest and in sclerophyll forest often on creek banks.
