- * Maori Maidens will travel with your clients from accommodation to village. Our wahine are dressed in traditional attire, meet and greet everyone. Great for photo opportunities with your guests.

- * Wetini Mitai (CEO / Founder of Mitai Maori Village) is the Male Leader for New Zealand in kapa haka (Maori performing arts and represents NZ on a very high scale).
- * View our traditional earth cooked hangi feast as it is uplifted from the earth oven
- * Watch in awe of the warriors as they arrive paddling an ancient war canoe, on our stream, surrounded by beautiful natural native bush
- * Enjoy a rich, powerful and informative maori cultural performance (45 mins duration)
- * Hangi served from a buffet – alongside dessert and salad. Please advise any special dietary requirements at time of reservation
- * Please advise if your client is celebrating a birthday, wedding anniversary or special occasion and we can acknowledge them during the evening.
- * Participate in a short education bush walk – learning of the flora and fauna and their medicinal purposes
- * View the majestic “Fairy Spring” - it is a spiritual and sacred spring to the Te Arawa tribe
- * View our glow worms in their natural habitat
- * Suitable for ALL ages and nationalities. Translation sheets available upon request
- * Recommend guests wear flat walking footwear and comfortable clothing suitable to the days weather conditions (including a jacket during the winter months).
- * Winter Schedule – commences at 5.30pm and concludes at 8.30pm (April – Sept) Pick up between 4.45-5.10pm. Guests who are self drive need to meet at Mitai Maori Village located at 196 Fairy Springs Road no later than 5.20pm.

- * Discussion on our adaptation to this land, our survival, our food sources, past times with interactive participation with the Poi (ball on the end of the string). The use of the various houses that are seen within the bush area, and their purpose
- * Learn of the plants and how they were used
- * View the waka (canoe) and learn about the great migration to New Zealand. The structure of the waka
- * Hear the beautiful calling of our maiden as she provides a traditional karanga (calling) welcoming your guests on to our land.
- * View the spiritual and sacred Fairy Spring – learn of its history and value to our people of the land
- * Enjoy a glass of water directly from the sacred spring, and sample Kawakawa tea. The Kawakawa is a plant located in our forest which offers several healing properties and is used on a regularly. Taste a slice of traditional Maori bread (Rewana Bread). The Rewana bread is made up from a 100 year old Mitai family recipe.
- * There are many photo Opportunities available
- * Guests can participate in both the Ancient World daytime and Mitai Maori Village evening experience as there is no duplication between these products
