## FINANCIAL INFORMATION

*as of August 1, 2017*

TUITION	\$2000 per year per student
BOOKS and SUPPLIES*	\$ 400 per year per student
APPLICATION FEE	\$ 10 for first time per student
REGISTRATION FEE	\$ 25 per year per student
TESTING FEE	\$ 10 per year per student
INSURANCE FEE	\$ 5 per year per student
ELECTIVE and ACTIVITY FEE	<i>varies according to the elective or activity</i>

*\* The Book and Supply Fee covers the cost of all consumable materials such as workbooks, etc. which become the property of the student. On average workbooks cost \$20 apiece. Text books are rented by the student but remain property of the school. On average textbooks cost \$40-75 apiece. It often happens that additional materials or out of print textbooks used in the classroom need to be photocopied and that additional photocopying cost is included here, inasmuch as it is above and beyond regular, the copying costs for the school are included in the tuition fee.*

*Partial scholarships may be available based upon a demonstrated financial need, and on an as available basis. Inquire with either Abp. Ford or Mrs. Bosse for information and an application.*

Payments can be made by cash, personal check, money order, cashier's check or by electronic deposit into the school's account. ALL payments must be made on time or there will be a \$25 fee added. Any checks returned as NSF will be subject to immediate rectification/payment in cash and a \$50 fee will be assessed as well. All payments except for direct deposits must be made on the **first school day** of each month. Any account **more than 7 days in arrears** will result in your child/children not being allowed to return to the school until the full arrearage and current assessments are paid in full. Financial statements to all parents/guardians will be distributed on the last school day of each month. **5% discount off of full tuition (only) per student, if paid in full before July 1, 2017.**
