  - Work closely with project team to collect all the updates about the projects for weekly publication
  - Gather current issues and stories in the areas of youth empowerment and girls’ reproductive health and TAI related focus areas
  - Create a media house database for every media house we work with
3. Preparing weekly multimedia content for all social media and website
  - Make a monthly multimedia content plan
  - Provide social media manager with weekly content for social media
  - Record all major activities and fun activities in form of video for a weekly YouTube content
  - Take well composed pictures for Facebook and Instagram newsfeed
4. Publication of news and press releases
  - Prepare press release for every event, project launch, or any major activity in the organization.
  - Write or collect one article that is about the issues that TAI deal with for the blog
  - Use the website TAI blog to put articles on a weekly basis,
