First, I would like to thank all the members who took time out of their busy schedule to attend the spring meeting. We went over all the changes for 2018, our budget and goals. We had in depth discussions and great ideas to incorporate into the future. Meeting in Lansing was more central for most attendees so it was suggested we use MSU for 2018 as well.

Sharon went over the treasurer's report, profit and loss with a projected deficit for 2018. Just looking at our bank balance is not an accurate picture of where we are as EMAA has been absorbing multiple increased expenses the past few years. The goal of the budget was to get us back on track without just raising costs for the members. Spending was put into reports and adjusted for 2018. This year regular classes will remain at thirteen dollars, specialty and dressage fifteen dollars per class. The pre-entry discount was reduced by two dollars and due to 100% loss on pre-entry the past few years, dressage will have no pre-entry discount. Camping and stalls went up by two dollars a day to offset the increase in fairgrounds rental and fees. Camping was also a focus this year as members plugging in at illegal areas cost the club one thousand dollars in fines. For 2018 there is a new process in place to eliminate the possibility of this reoccurrence.

We went over the show bill for 2018 and discussed member preferences for rings at Shiawassee and splitting the main ring vs using alternative rings on Saturday. It was decided that we would use the outdoor ring at Shiawassee for main ring classes (weather permitting) and move dressage down to the lower arena. We went over logistics for Saturday and because showmanship will be "show and go", we will divide the main ring on Saturday morning. We had a great group of members attend and hope for an even greater turnout next year.

Kelly talked about her new program incorporating the Ride for the Gold, partnering with Angel Heart Farms. I hope that many of our youth participate to spread awareness of this great cause.

# From the Dressage Ring

Looking forward to seeing everyone soon at our 1<sup>st</sup> show of the season! A few reminders:

- PLEASE check the posted schedule at the show to ensure your test and class is correct.
- It is imperative that you check in with the gatekeeper to confirm your name and test/division upon arrival at the dressage ring. She will confirm the order of go so you are prepared and the judge/scribe has your correct test pulled to score.
- Welcome all new exhibitors to EMAA, we are glad to have you!
- Don't forget to sign up for weekend High score for Dressage. An award is presented at the banquet for those signed up that have the highest score at each level of test.
- Novice horse/rider combo is intended for a new horse/rider combo riding that particular test.
- Please check in at the show office upon arrival to make sure you are entered in the correct class and that matches what the dressage schedule indicates. This will help with accurate placing in the correct class.
- If the schedule on Signupgenius fills up, I will add ride times where I can.
- If it is full, please email me your name/horse name, and class/tests to be on the waiting list. We are often able to accommodate most rides with cancellations that take place.
