## CALL FOR TRANSLATORS

### **We are looking for translators to support our teams in Athens and Chios**

Since May 2017, Equal Rights Beyond Borders (formerly known as refugee law clinics broad) has been working with a small team on the Greek island of Chios, offering legal information to those seeking protection and who are supposed to be deported to Turkey after the EU-Turkey statement took into effect. The focus of our work lies on the preparation for and accompaniment to asylum interviews and support in family reunion procedures under the Dublin III Regulation.

In October, we opened an office in Athens that will focus on family reunification under the Dublin III Regulation. In addition, we are also working on advocacy and research projects.

In order to ensure a qualified and neutral translation Equal Rights is looking for translators in **Arabic, Farsi and Kurdish** (fluent or preferably mother tongue) who is speaking English (at least Level B2). Desirably you will also have experience in translating.

### Requirements

- Minimum stay of two months
- native Arabic / Farsi / Kurdish speaker
- preferably experience in translation
- Very good knowledge of English
- High resilience and ability to cope with a high workload
- Possibility of self-financing the assignment (e.g. scholarship via
- Erasmus+ or DAAD, or own funds)
