## ABOUT THE EVENT

In February of 2020, a dedicated group of individuals are climbing Mount Kilimanjaro in honor of Special Olympics Connecticut. Located in Tanzania and standing at 19,341', "Kili" is the tallest peak in Africa and the tallest mountain in the world measuring from base to summit. Law Enforcement Officers and civilians from across the state will make this climb, planting the flag at the summit in honor of our brave Special Olympics athletes who climb mountains of their own every day.
