APPLICATION PACKET OVERVIEW

Dear Applicant,

The 100 Black Men of Greater Columbia, Inc. is committed to the growth and development of America's youth. In addition to engaging in mentoring, education, health & wellness, and economic development programs, we feel it is important to aid in developing talented young Americans in pursuit of higher education. Through gifts provided by our corporate sponsors and friends, the 100 Black Men of Greater Columbia, Inc. is able to provide scholarships to deserving college students on an equal opportunity basis regardless of race, sex, creed or religious preference.

The 100 Black Men of Greater Columbia, Inc.'s Scholarship application is available to students who maintain full-time status at an accredited, post-secondary institution beginning in the fall of the year. Applicants must meet all of the eligibility requirements and deadlines to qualify. Scholarship awards are \$500 per academic year and are renewable for up to four years (for a maximum award of \$2,000). Scholarships should be applied towards tuition, room, board, and books. Checks will be mailed from the 100 Black Men of Greater Columbia, Inc.'s office and made payable to the scholarship recipient.

All completed applications must be submitted via U.S. mail. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. **Application packets must be submitted no later than November 15, 2019.** Notification of scholarships will be sent to all applicants by the spring of 2020. Formal scholarship presentations will be made at the Annual Scholarship and Awards Banquet in May 2020.

Eligibility Criteria

- High school seniors transitioning to college
- Minimum grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Planning to attend an institution for an entire academic year, beginning in the fall of 2020 (verification of enrollment will be required before scholarship is received)

Scholarship Application

The 100 Black Men of Greater Columbia, Inc.'s Scholarship application will be available after September 20, 2019. It may be acquired from our local office or our website at www.100blackmencolumbiasc.com.

Essay

Applicants are required to submit a 500-word or less essay that answers the following two questions. The essay must be typed in 12-point font and double spaced.

- 1. Why do you need financial assistance in the form of a scholarship?**
- 2. How would a scholarship specifically benefit you during your college enrollment?**

Official Academic Transcript

Applicants must request an **official** academic transcript from their most recent high school. **All transcripts must have an official raised seal and/or official signature to be valid.** Transcripts that do not have a raised seal and/or signature will not be accepted. Class schedules, report cards, or progress reports will not be accepted. **Official academic transcripts must be submitted with the application packet.**

Verification of Financial Need Letter

Applicants must demonstrate their financial need as indicated by a letter of verification from a teacher, guidance counselor, or other school official with knowledge of the student's financial need.

Recommendation Letter

Applicants must submit one letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, non-related family member, or community organization that highlights the student's scholastic achievement, extracurricular and community service involvement.
