DESCRIPTION

PeaceMaker should be used in spray applications where pesticide requires an ammonium sulfate or ammonium nitrate type additive. It is formulated to minimize corrosiveness or abrasiveness to spray nozzles. Peacemaker should also be used with pesticides that are enhanced by acidic spray solutions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

PeaceMaker is intended for use with herbicides such as Glyphosate Products, Poast, Gramoxone Inteon and any others where ammonium sulfate is recommended. Rate of PeaceMaker may vary with the conditions of application. Add as the last ingredient when mixing with wettable powders, dispersible granules, and other materials designed to be mixed with plain water. Add first when spraying materials sensitive to hard water or high pH. Always add with agitator running. Always read and follow the entire pesticide label for proper timing rates, specific directions and any special use precautions or regional use recommendations.

If the pesticide manufacture requires the use of a surfactant, then always include a non-ionic surfactant labeled for such use, such as Native Earth ADMIT-ALL. Surfactant must contain at least 90% active ingredient.

RATES

Use 1 to 4 pints per 100 gallons of spray solution.

GENERAL MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

The addition of an adjuvant to some pesticides or pesticide tank mix combinations may cause phytotoxicity to susceptible crops. For tank mixes, add this product last. If physical compatibility is unknown, use a jar compatibility test. Note: Use caution when tank mixing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in original container only and keep sealed. Store in closed storage areas. Use caution when moving, opening, closing or pouring. DO NOT contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal.
