The Neighbourhood Alert system is available anywhere across Thames Valley. The website provides access to the interactive tools, including messaging facilities. It's a free service that enables residents of Thames Valley to engage with Thames Valley Police and Neighbourhood Watch, as well as other selected organisations. You do not need to be involved with Neighbourhood Watch to join, but if you are, the free scheme management tools give you access to an extensive range of support and resources. The Neighbourhood Alert system is hosted and supported by VISAV Limited.

What do you get?

- A totally free service. No monthly, annual or incoming text or phone charges.
- Information about crime trends, incidents and requests for info by voicemail, text or email.
- Start, manage or request to join a Neighbourhood Watch scheme.
- Configure exactly how, when and what priority of messages you would like to receive.
- Unsubscribe at any time – there are no contracts, costs or obligations.
- Remain unseen on the system or make your scheme visible for other members to join.

Data Privacy Statement

Who can see your data?

VISAV Limited (VISAV) is both a data controller and a data processor. Public authority and safety organisations are represented on the Neighbourhood Alert system, these are called Information Providers (IP).

Each IP is a Data Controller and responsible for ensuring that access to data is restricted appropriately. Your data will not be shared without your explicit, opt-in consent and you can withdraw this permission at any time by logging in, using the settings button on any Alert email or contacting VISAV.

Why we need your data

This is so that IPs will be able to send you messages and manage the growth of active citizen based communities. Messages are tailored to your requirements by the information you provide at registration or subsequently by logging into your account or answering surveys.

Your rights

You have the right to unsubscribe, check, object and have your data deleted. You can also request a copy of your information in a structured, electronic format.
