## GRAND PRIZE AND PRIZE DRAWINGS FORMAT

Grand Prize Drawing for 2017 Ranger Bass Boat will be held at Grand Lake Casino on November 12, 2017. Drawing time will be 5:00 PM. All participant entries will be placed in a single drawing hopper and one winning ticket will be selected. The owner of the grand prize entry selected from the hopper will then be announced and the drawing winner will have two minutes to report to the tournament director. If the selected winner is not present, another entry will be drawn and this process will continue until a winner is found.

## SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

**Friday, November 10th:** All contestants must check in at Grand Lake Casino Friday November 10th from 3:00 PM-10:00 PM for weigh in locations and entry into the Grand Prize Ranger Boat drawing and other prizes from our great sponsors. All boats must be off the water by 6:00 PM.

**Saturday, November 11th:** First cast 6:30 AM at 3:00 PM all fish retained and not weighed must be released; all boats must be off the water by 6:00 PM Saturday November 11th. First days hourly payouts will be awarded beginning at 6:00 PM at Grand Lake Casino.

**Sunday, November 12th:** First cast 6:30 AM at 3:00 PM all fish retained and not weighed must be released. Final awards ceremony and Ranger Boat Draw plus other great prizes will begin at 5:00 PM at Grand Lake Casino.

## OFFICIAL BI-HOURLY WEIGH-IN TIME SLOTS EACH DAY ARE: 6:30AM - 9AM | 9AM - 11AM | 11AM - 1PM | 1PM - 3PM

**RULES AND REGULATIONS:** It is the responsibility of all contestants to read all rules and regulations prior to signing entry form. A valid Oklahoma Fishing license, Current Boat Registration, Operating Kill Switch, Lifejackets, Throw Cushions and Operating Live-well will be subject to verification when weighing fish. **DECISIONS:** All decisions of the Tournament Director are FINAL. **ELIGIBILITY:** 1. All State and Federal penal code laws shall apply at all times. All State, Coast Guard, Federal Parks and Wildlife regulations apply at all times. 2. This tournament is open to all anglers age 18 or older with the exclusion of Grand Lake Guides who have guided for any compensation during the last 90 days prior to this event. **Must be 18 or older to be eligible for Grand Prize drawings!** 3. Only registered contestants are allowed in the boat and only for the days they have registered. 4. Tournament Officials have the right to refuse any entry; anyone who has ever been disqualified from a bass tournament is ineligible to compete. **REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE:** Entry fee with completed entry form must be received prior to fishing. Once entry fee has been received there will be no refund of entries or substitutions of angler. All contestants must check in at Grand Lake Casino Friday November 10th from 3:00 PM-10PM for weigh in locations and entry into the Grand Prize Ranger Boat drawing and other prizes from our great sponsors. **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:** No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs may be consumed, or on board of tournament boats during tournament hours. **PERMITTED FISHING HOURS:** 1. Only bass legally caught between the hours of 6:30AM and 3:00PM Saturday November 11, 2017 may be weighed on Day 1. 2. Only bass legally caught between the hours of 6:30AM and 3:00PM Sunday November 12, 2017 may be weighed on Day 2. **OFF LIMITS:** No fishing is allowed during **OFF LIMITS** which begins at 6:00 PM prior to each tournament day and ends at 6:30 AM of each tournament day. Any area marked keep out or no fishing by local, state or federal authorities is off limits to competitors. **SAFETY:** Kill switch must be attached to boat operator anytime combustion motor is in gear. A US Coast Guard Approved life jacket must be on and fastened to all anglers anytime combustion motor is in gear and underway. **TACKLE AND EQUIPMENT:** All bass must be caught on artificial lures only while casting. No trolling with big motor. Contestants may use only one rod at a time. No electronic tracking devices (microchips) or underwater cameras may be used during tournament hours. **WEIGH IN, SPORTSMANSHIP AND CONSERVATION:** 1. Sportsmanship, courtesy, safety and conservation are required and expected from every contestant. 2. Trailering is permissible. 3. Bass must be alive to be weighed, no exceptions and no bass on ice. 4. All bass brought to weigh in must be in weigh bag with ample water. 5. No contestant may weigh more than one bass per hour, with only one bass per weigh in bag allowed. No contestant may have more than 3 bass in their possession during tournament hours. No ties, 1st heaviest fish weighed in wins that prize with the following place going to the angler with same weight. 6. Bass must be weighed in by the angler who legally caught the bass during tournament hours. 7. Any artificially weighed or preserved bass will be disqualified and the contestant will be subject to prosecution under state and federal laws. 8. Any questionable bass weighed will be subject to inspection by a marine biologist and/or similarly qualified expert. 9. Official measuring board is the **PRO-RULE**. Minimum length of all bass to be weighed is 14". A courtesy board will be available at each weigh in. 10. This is a mandatory Catch and Release program during Official Tournament Hours. At the end of each tournament day all bass caught and not weighed must be released back into Grand Lake. **POLYGRAPH AND QUALITY ASSURANCE TEST:** Each contestant entered into this tournament is subject to Quality Assurance Tests. Test may include polygraph, urinalysis, or blood test. Test will be given at random and must be passed.
