#### 1. OVERVIEW

# **Purpose**

The Giving Circle Scholarship Fund was founded to assist an African American student from the Chicagoland area in obtaining their undergraduate degree by providing them with financial assistance and supporting their collegiate development.

### Financial Assistance

An award made on behalf of the Giving Circle Scholarship Fund is based on academic performance, leadership potential, level of perseverance, and community involvement. Scholarships are awarded by semester, provided funds are available. Funds from the Giving Circle Scholarship Fund should be used for education-related expenses such as tuition and course material.

# Scholarship Awards

The Giving Circle Scholarship Fund awards scholarships through a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Short Essay Prompts and Financial Need. The Giving Circle Scholarship Fund pays funds directly to educational institutions. Scholarships are awarded by semester, considering the recipient is compliant. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and qualifying criteria.

#### Criteria

Applicants must be completing high school with a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Applicants must be accepted as a full-time student at a college or university for the upcoming academic semester. The college or university will receive the funds directly on behalf of the awarded student.

Preference will be given to first-generation students and those with a great financial need.

Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by June 24th.

#### Timeline

June 24th: Applications are due.

June 25th: Candidates may be asked for an interview by the Scholarship

Committee.

July 1st: Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship.

July 31st: Award recipient must officially accept the Scholarship.

# **Application Process**

Scholarship applicants must provide the below documentation by June 24th:

- 1. Completed Application (incomplete applications will not be considered)
- 2. Official High School Transcript
- 3. Administrator Form
- 4. One Letter of Academic Reference
- 5. One Letter of Personal Reference
- 6. Official Acceptance Letter from a College or University

# Scholarship Disbursement Process

Awarded student must complete verification form which grants access to the Giving Circle Scholarship Fund to academic and financial aid records, along with verifying enrollment and enrollment status.

Award amounts will be distributed after each semester once all compliance is confirmed. The first disbursement of the award will be given on August 15th, or once verification has been received and reflects the information by the guidelines of the Scholarship.
