(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow reinstatement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Denstroude Lane, Dunkirk.

A closure is planned from 20th January 2020, with estimated completion by 22nd January 2020, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00620255355 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [one.network](#)

Denstroude Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of Denstroude House, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

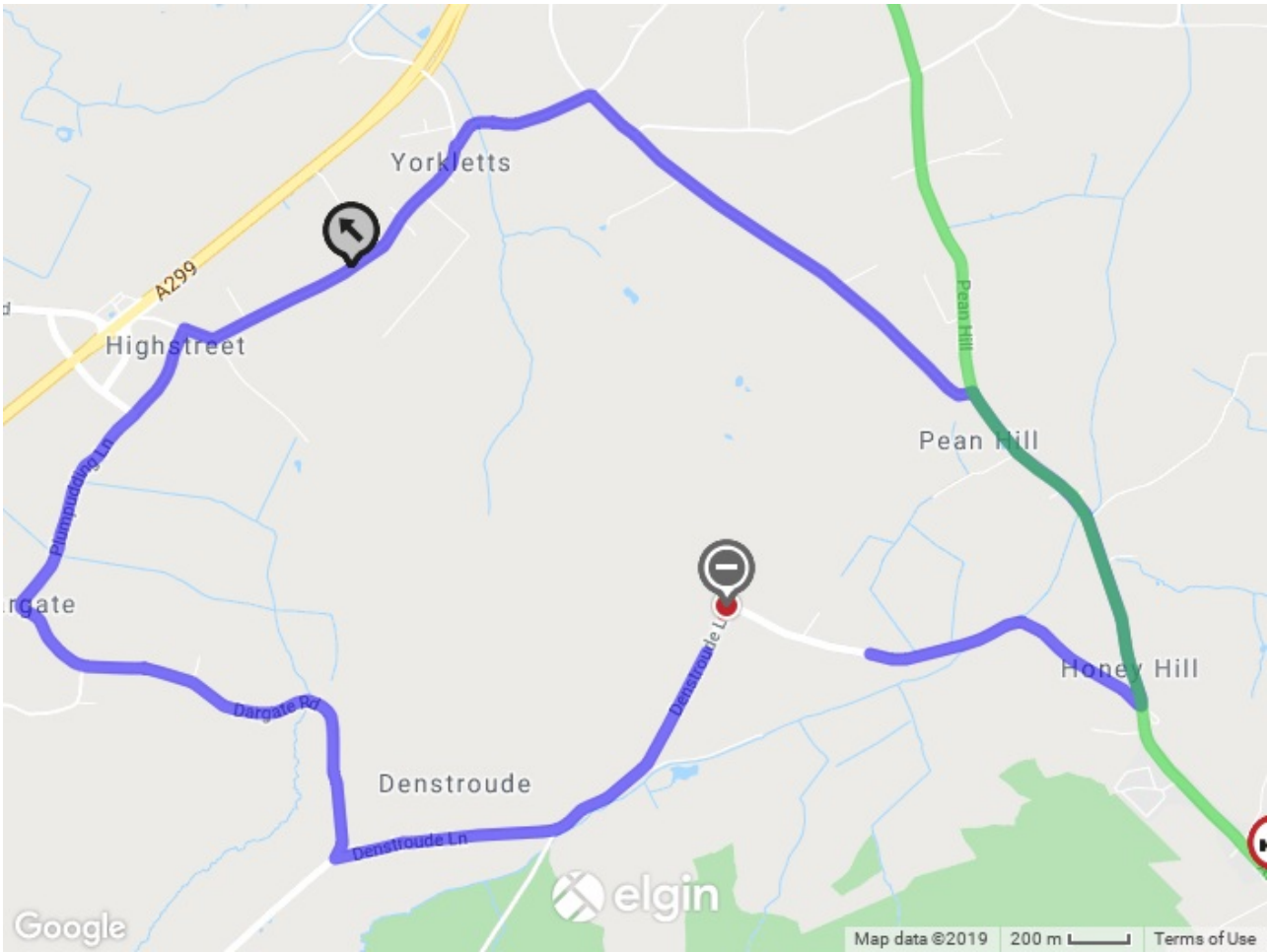
The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while reinstatement works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Denstroude Lane, Dargate Road, Plumpudding Lane, Fox's Cross Hill, Fox's Cross Road, Pean Hill, Honey Hill and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to reopen the road outside of working hours.
