



**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**Monkshill Road, Hernhill**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

To allow water main connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Monkshill Road, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 11th January 2020, with estimated completion by 12th January 2020. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works permit will be displayed on [one.network](#)

Monkshill Road will be closed in the general vicinity of Monkshill Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

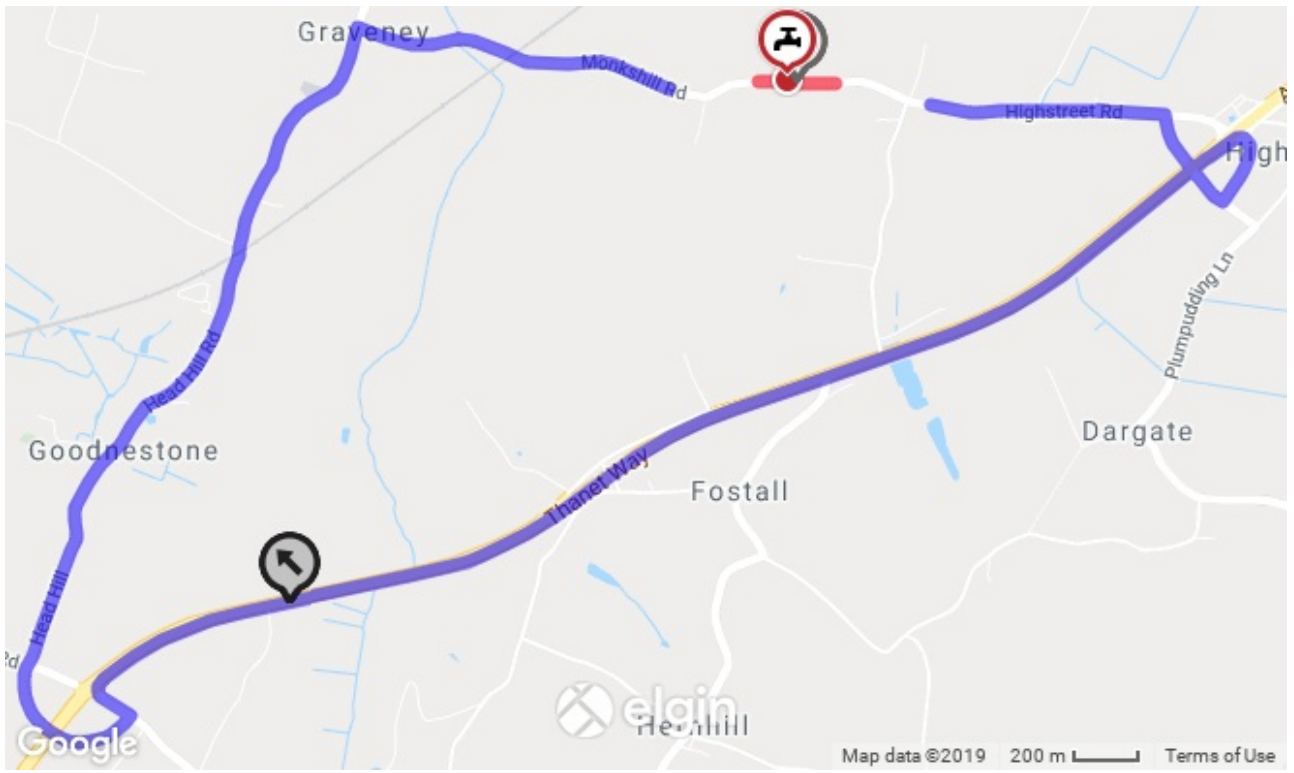
The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while water main connection works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Highstreet Road, Plumpudding Lane, A299 Thanet Way, Thanet Way Slip, Staple Street, Staple Street Road, Head Hill, Head Hill Road, Seasalter Road, Monkshill Road and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to reopen the road outside of working hours.
