



**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**Staplestreet Road, Hernhill**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

To allow works to be carried out to install a new gas service, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Staplestreet Road, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 27th January 2020, with estimated completion by 31st January 2020, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW046W116715009-10439 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [one.network](#)

Staplestreet Road will be closed in the general vicinity of Mountfield Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

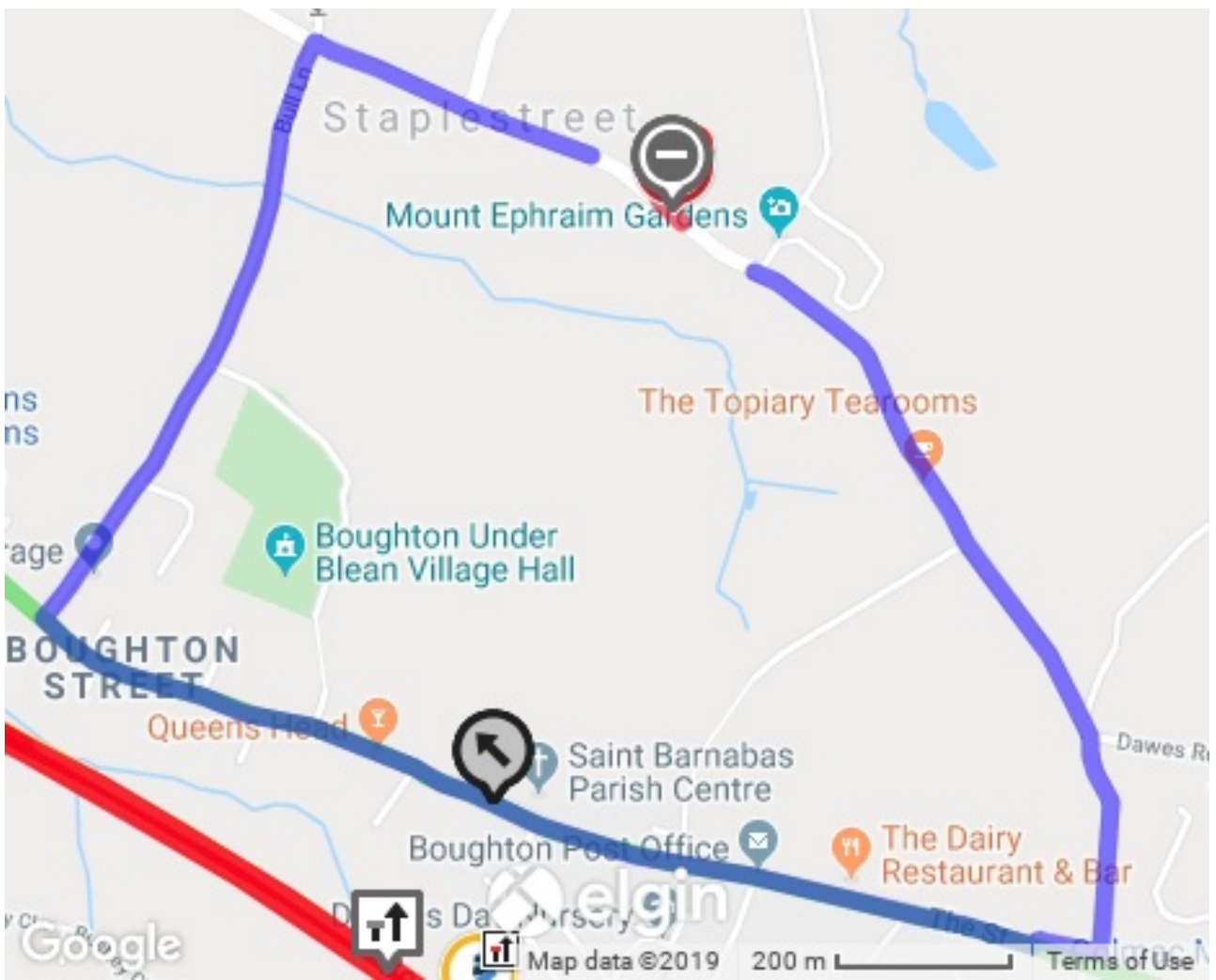
The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while gas main service works are undertaken by SGN.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Bull Lane, The Street, Staplestreet Road and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to reopen the road outside of working hours.
