Staple Street, Hernhill
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new service, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Staple Street, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 11th May 2020, between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, with estimated completion by 12th May 2020, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC005CC1W00000WAMNFR5B1 - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [one.network](#)

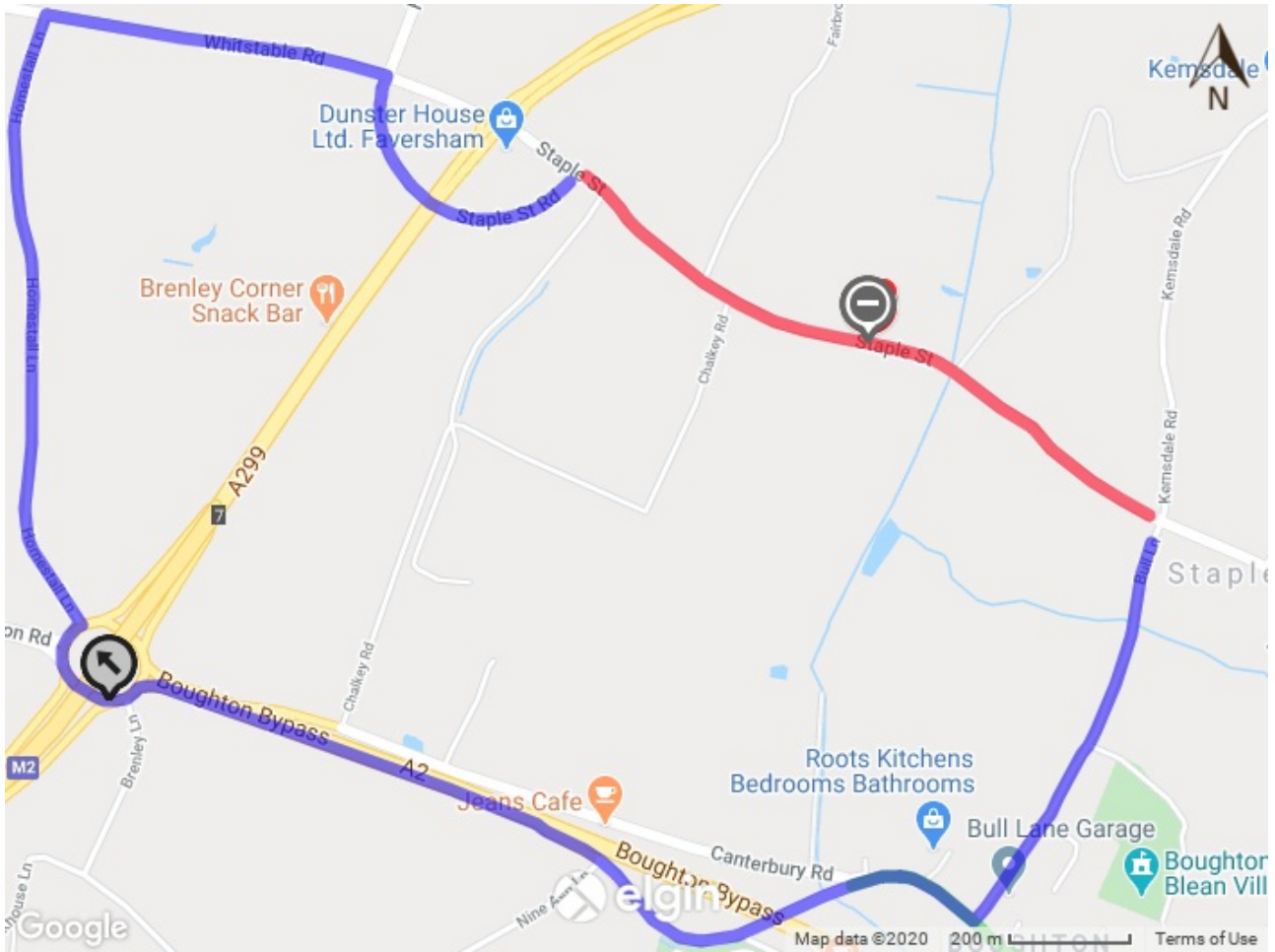
Staple Street will be closed between the junctions with Bull Lane and Staple Street Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while works to provide a new service are undertaken by BT.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Bull Lane, Stockers Hill, Canterbury Road, Boughton Bypass, Brenley Corner, Homestall Lane, Whitstable Road, Staple Street Road and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
