A2 Boughton Street Drainage Works

What's happening?

I am writing to advise that A-one+, on behalf of Highways England will be carrying out drainage works on the verges and central reservations of the A2 carriageway between Brenley Corner Roundabout and Dunkirk.

Traffic Management

In order to carry out these works as efficiently and safely as possible, works will be carried out during overnight full directional carriageway closures and overnight lane closures between 8pm and 6am including weekends. 24/7 Narrow lanes will also be in place on both carriageways; dates provided below. To minimise disruption to motorists and local residents, works for the ongoing Brenley Corner Toucan Scheme will also take place utilising these closures. There will be no works taking place during the Easter weekend, Thursday 9 April to Monday 13 April 2020.

Back to Back Lane 2 closures between Brenley Corner Roundabout and Dunkirk; both Coast Bound and London Bound	Monday 10 February to Friday 28 February 2020; Monday to Saturday Only - 8pm to 6am
A2 Full Coast Bound carriageway closure from Brenley Corner Roundabout to Dunkirk	Saturday 29 February & Sunday 1 March 2020; 8pm to 6am only
A2 Full London Bound carriageway closure from Thanington to Brenley Corner Roundabout	Monday 2 March & Tuesday 3 March 2020; 8pm to 6am only
A2 Coast Bound carriageway restriction – Two narrow lanes running between Brenley Corner Roundabout to Dunkirk	Sunday 1 March to Tuesday 24 March 2020; inclusive ** 24 hours

A2 London Bound carriageway restriction - Single lane running; Lane 1, between Dunkirk and Brenley Corner Roundabout	Tuesday 3 March to Wednesday 25 March 2020; inclusive ** 24 hours
Various lane closures of the A2 carriageway from Brenley Corner Roundabout to Dunkirk, both Coast bound and London bound	Thursday 26 March to Friday 24 April 2020; Monday to Saturday Only - 8pm to 6am Not including Easter break between Thursday 9 April & Monday 13 April

**** Please be aware of corresponding full directional closure dates within this time.**

Diversions- clearly signed diversions will be in place during all closures utilising local routes, suitable for all types of vehicles when full closures of the carriageway are in place.

A2 Coast Bound carriageway from Brenley Corner Roundabout to Dunkirk closure - Saturday 29 February & Sunday 1 March 2020: Traffic on the coast bound M2 will be diverted at junction 7 to continue north along the A299. Traffic will remain on the A299 until it can join the southbound A253 at Monkton roundabout, where traffic will take the first exit at the Canterbury Road Roundabout to join the southbound A28 which will take traffic to the Canterbury ring Road. Traffic will then turn left onto the A2050 in order to join the Coastbound A2 where the diversion ends. During this closure, there will be a manned closure on Staple Street to prevent unsuitable vehicles, also the north bound entry slip from the A299 onto Staple Street will be closed, however local residents will be permitted.

A2 London Bound carriageway closure from Thanington to Brenley Corner Roundabout - Monday 2 March 2020 & Tuesday 3 March 2020: Traffic looking to join or continue along the London bound A2 at Canterbury will be diverted to exit the A2 at the A2050 exit to join the North bound Roman Road onto the Canterbury ring road, turning right onto the A28 towards Sarre. Traffic will then follow the A253 towards Monkton Roundabout, where traffic will take the first exit to join the A299. Traffic will remain on the A299 in order to join the M2 at junction 7, Brenley Corner Roundabout, where the diversion ends. Hotel patrons, local residents and services staff will need to make their way to the manned hard closure on the A2050 past Kent College Junior School, where they will be escorted. Please be advised that a postcode for destinations within the closure will need to be provided.
