Monkshill Road, Hernhill
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow cabling works to be carried out to restore BT customers out of service, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Monkshill Road, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 2nd June 2020 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC005CC1W0000PTMS4434801 - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [one.network](#)

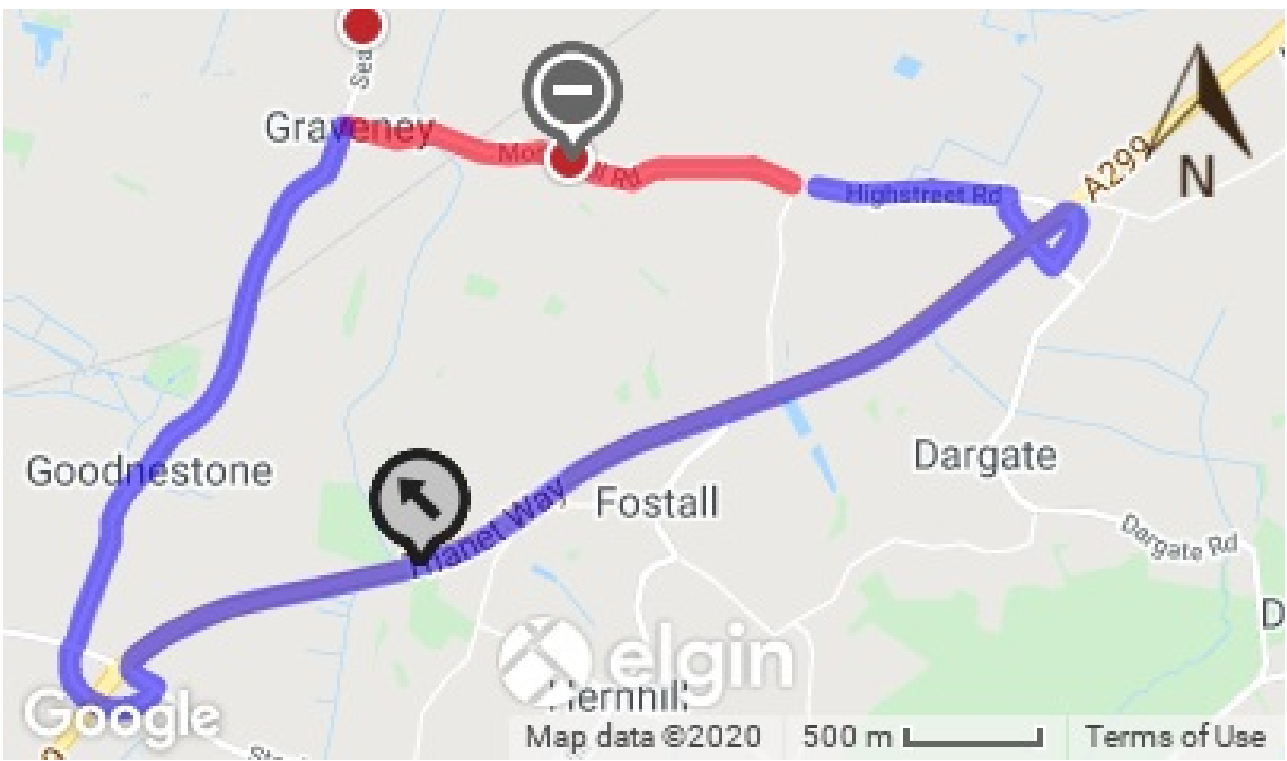
Monkshill Road will be closed between the junctions with Seasalter Road and Westerham Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while cabling works are undertaken by BT.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Highstreet Road, Unnamed Road From Highstreet Road To Plumpudding Lane, Thanet Way, Thanet Way Slip, Staple Street, Staple Street Road, Head Hill, Head Hill Road, Seasalter Road and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
