(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow works to be carried out on overhead structure, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Plumpudding Lane, Dargate.

A closure is planned from 5th August 2020 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC005OP1W0000PTMS131149A - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [one.network](#)

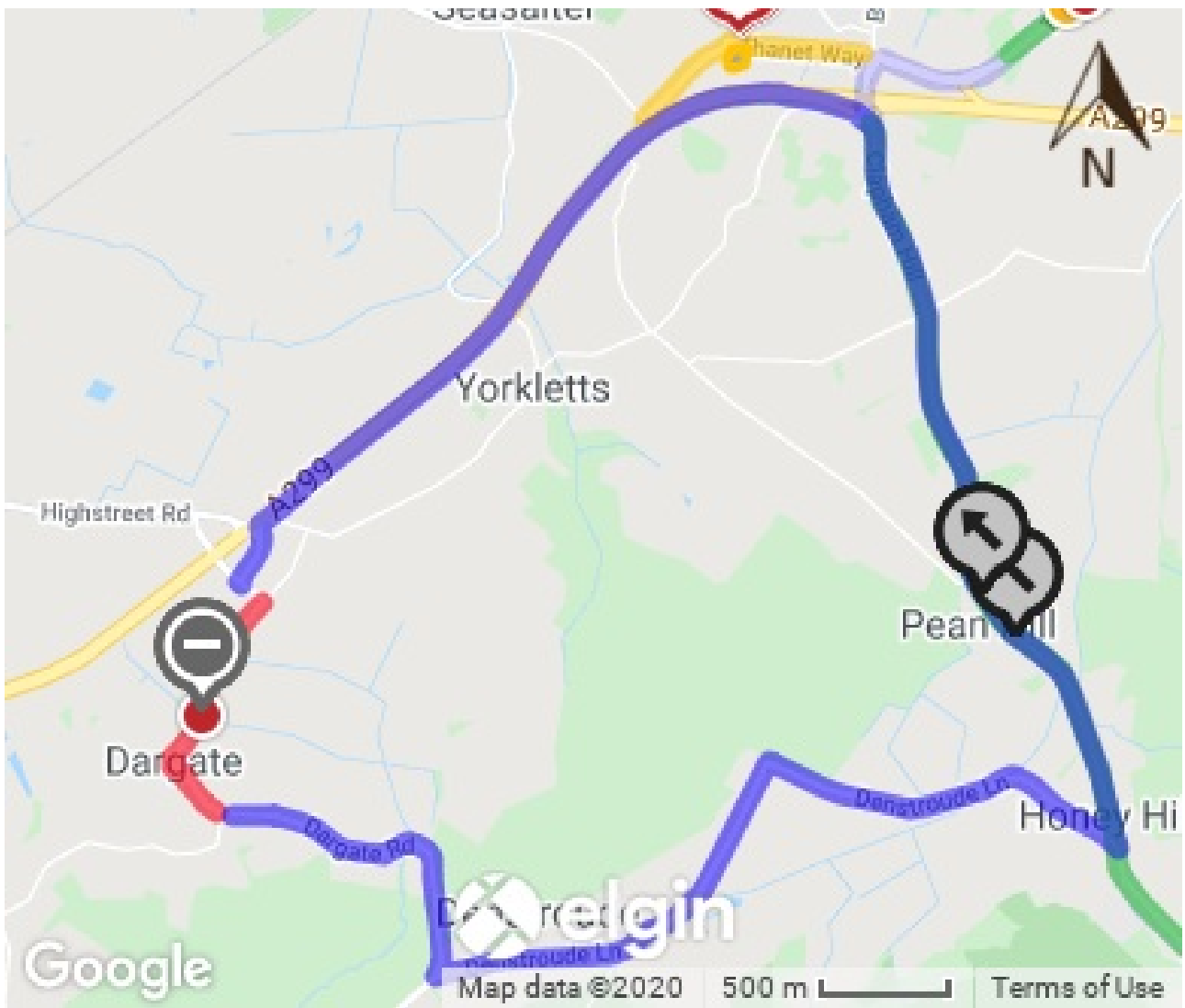
Plumpudding Lane will be closed between the junctions with Dargate Road and Unnamed Road from High Street to Plumpudding Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while overhead structure works are undertaken by BT.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Dargate Road, Denstroude Lane, Honey Hill, Pean Hill, Clapham Hill, Westbound Slip Onto A299 From Wraik Hill Roundabout, Thanet Way, Unnamed Road From Highstreet Road To Plumpudding Lane and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
