- A. Planning Applications - 19/506005/FULL Replacement windows to front, side and rear elevations. *Church Farm House Church Hill Hernhill Faversham Kent ME13 9JW*

The applicant attended the meeting and explained that they wish to replace the windows at the front side and rear. The current windows are not fit for purpose in that they incorrectly fit the window openings leaving large gaps and are of poor quality and efficiency. They showed a photograph of the house in the early 20th century and commented that the replacement design was to revert back to the original look and feel. The current uPVC sash windows are to be replaced with uPVC sash wood grain effect. Some councillors asked if the replacement windows could be made of timber but it was felt that as the existing windows are upvc it would be unreasonable to expect the applicant to go to the large extra expense that she said she could not afford. The Chairman commented that this would be more in keeping with the other windows elsewhere on The Green and will be an improvement and be more aesthetically pleasing and in keeping with that of the Conservation Area. The Councillors voted three in favour with one abstaining. The council support the application in that it will be an improvement on the current windows and is aesthetically pleasing.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the Meeting closed.
