Staple Street, Hernhill
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

Kent County Council gives notice that Staple Street, Hernhill will be closed to through traffic, on or after 9 December 2019 for up to 2 nights.

The road will be closed at the junction with Staple Street Road.

It will also be necessary to close the A299 west-bound off slip at this location.

The alternative route is via A299 Thanet Way to Brenley Corner and back.

It is planned that the road will be closed between the hours of 20:00 and 06:00.

The closure is necessary to enable A-One + to control traffic with "gated access" and HGV movements while Toucan crossing installation works are undertaken at Brenley Corner.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barrier are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
