- IV. Terms**
- If your vehicle is parked in the Environmental Services area for more than seven (7) days, all fluids must be removed.
 - A photograph of the item being placed in the lot must accompany this application, prior to a key being issued.
 - For the purpose of this regulation, a vehicle includes any kind of motorized vehicle, trailers and boats that are secured onto a trailer for transportation. Small boats that can be carried by a single person may be stored without a trailer.
 - The undersigned hereby agrees and understands that the Village of Terrace Park is not responsible for this vehicle or its contents while parked in the Environmental Services Area.

- The undersigned understands and accepts that the permission to park a vehicle in the Environmental Services Area may be revoked at any time by the Village of Terrace Park if use of the Environmental Services Area is abused.
- The undersigned further understands that he/she is responsible to keep the vehicle in good condition while it is parked in the Environmental Services Area. If any vehicle is determined by the Village to be abandoned or unroadworthy, such vehicle must be removed from the service area if the vehicle is not restored to acceptable condition within 30 days of notice. Notice to remove the vehicle shall be sent by regular mail to the address of the owner set forth above.
- A separate registration must be filed and approved for each vehicle. No more than two vehicles may be registered for any single household. No boat may be stored in the Environmental Services Area unless it is secured to a trailer that is suitable for transporting said boat or unless the boat is designed to be carried by a single person. The combination of boat and trailer shall be considered one vehicle for the purpose of counting vehicles.
- If an abandoned or unroadworthy vehicle is not removed in accordance with these regulations, then the undersigned hereby authorizes the Village to cause the removal of the vehicle from the service area at the expense of the owner. The undersigned understands that the Village of Terrace Park is not responsible or liable for any damage to the vehicle or its contents as a result of the removal and off-site storage of said vehicle. The undersigned hereby holds the Village harmless from any claims it may have any such losses.
- The undersigned understands that for purposes of this regulation, an abandoned vehicle means any vehicle that is not currently licensed or which is not owned by a current resident of the Village of Terrace Park.
- The undersigned further understands that an unroadworthy vehicle means a vehicle that has one or more of the following defects:
 - a) If designed to be self-propelled, the vehicle does not properly start.
 - b) If designed to be self-propelled, the vehicle does not propel itself under its own power.
 - c) Any of the headlights, tail lights, turn signals, parking lights or license plate lights do not operate properly.
 - d) Any windshields, windows and/or rearview mirrors are not intact or display any cracks or other defects that, in the opinion of the Village, would impede the vision of the operator of the vehicle and thereby impede the safe operation of said vehicle.
 - e) The vehicle emits excessive exhaust fumes when starting or in the course of operation.

- f) The muffler, in the opinion of the Village, sounds defective or excessively loud when the vehicle is operated.
- g) The standard passenger or driver seats are not present or not in a good and usable condition.
- h) Any one or more tires on said vehicle are either not in good condition or not properly inflated.
- i) The vehicle displays significant rust spots or other damage to the body.

The undersigned applicant understands and agrees that no repairs or maintenance of any vehicle is permitted in the services area unless it is minor and can be completed within two consecutive hours. If repairs are commenced but not completed, the vehicle will be subject to immediate removal.
