#### **BETTER BLOCK**

#### **BETTER BLOCK (2017)**

#### THE PROJECT

The Better Block project in 2017 addressed both sides of Kenmore Boulevard, from 16th Street to approximately 13th Street. The area was chosen due to a number of factors: its potential for partnerships with local businesses, lack of street level parking lots (a huge benefit to the continuity of the block), vacant buildings that could be used to house pop-ups, an empty lot that could be converted into public space, and the two bus stops located on Kenmore Boulevard. The 13th Street to 16th Street stretch of Kenmore Boulevard is the core of the business district and, should long-term redevelopment occur, will become the economic center of the neighborhood.








#### OVERALL RECOMMENDATIONS

- ROAD IMPROVEMENTS
  - Investigate potential for road diet at Carnegie Ave and Manchester Rd, Waterloo Rd near Conrad Ave and Edwin Ave, along Manchester Rd near Stanford St
  - Explore Manchester Rd bypass removal
- PARKS AND OPEN SPACES
  - 1 Summit Lake Master Plan
  - Sound barrier needed for Chestnut Ridge Park
  - 3 Chestnut Ridge Akron Park Challenge Winner
  - Construct foot/bike path round Nesmith Lake
  - 5 Potential to work with MetroParks to create park/trails at City Nursey
- PEDESTRIAN CONNECTIONS
  - 1 Improve pedestrian crossings near Summit Lake on Manchester Rd
  - Proposed pedestrian loop path near Summit Lake Blvd and Lagoon Ave
  - Build stairway directly from bridge down to Blvd
  - Evaluate possibility of footbridge: to Towpath at Corey, at Pike Ave and at Stanford St

#### FUNDING SOURCES

Akron Parks Challenge Grant	(Chestnut Ridge Park)
Reimagine the Civic Commons	(Towpath, trail head, wayfinding/branding, and other improvements relating to connection to Towpath and Summit Lake)
Great Streets Program	(Façade improvements; projecting signs, etc.)
