

SCHOOL BOARDBoard Officers

The officers of the Board of Education shall be a President, a Vice President, a Secretary and an appointed Treasurer.

The President shall be elected from the members of the School Board. The Secretary need not be a member of the School Board.

The term of office shall be for two (2) years, unless the School Board, by resolution establishes a term of other length.

If the President is absent from any meeting or refuses to perform his/her duties, the Vice-President shall perform the duties of the office.

If the Secretary is absent from any meeting or refuses to perform his/her duties, a secretary protempore who shall be a member of the School Board shall be appointed.

Vacancies occurring in an office during the year shall be filled by special election for the remainder of the term.
