

Belly Button Brush



Tips

GENERIC - The first page (technically page 2) is the generic, one-size-fits-all version of the poem. This can be used for *anyone*. I have this many on a page for if you're going to be mass producing them, as for a bazaar, cute and humorous little gifts for everyone in a classroom, or at an event, like a BBQ, bridal or baby shower, party for kids through adults... anything that you'd like a funny, inexpensive, quick little gift for.

GRADS - The next page (page 3) is slightly revised to be perfect for a graduate.

BRIDE & GROOM / 1 brush - The next page (page 4) is to give *one* brush to the bride and groom.

BRIDE & GROOM / 2 brushes - The next page (page 5) is to give the bride and groom, but to give *two* brushes instead of just one. When doing two, I like to give .

ALL FOUR - The last page has one of each of the four for if you only want to give one.

TO PRINT:

WHICH PAGES: In your printing program, you will need to specifically select which page(s) you want to print. If you *don't* do this, "default" is that *all* of the pages will print.

WHAT TO PRINT ONTO: You *can* print them onto paper, but I think that cardstock looks nicer, and, because it's sturdier, it definitely holds up better.

HOW TO CUT THEM APART - This part is a bit tricky because there wasn't any way to put lines for the edges. That's not ideal anyway because it's impossible to avoid having the lines show. So if you're using the recommended 2" X 3" mini zip-top baggies, you want the topper to be 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ " wide by 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches long, and then divide that in half which should leave a tiny margin above the top line to the fold. If you're printing and using the whole page of them, you'll need to be more exact than if you're just doing one or a few. (You have some playing room if you are not needing to utilize all of them on the page.) I spent several *hours* trying to get all of these to work just right, but I still can't guarantee it. After you do one or two, you'll have it figured out! But if there are some obvious glitches (spacing is wrong), please let me know ~ and I do need you to be very specific about what isn't right.
