



MAN GIFT-IN-A-JAR BELLY BAND

- I printed label on glossy photo cardstock because I like the shininess, plus the letters and graphics show up nice and clear on it. But you can print on plain cardstock. Paper would work too, but it would be a bit thin.
- The jar is about 121/4 inches around, so an 11-inch long paper isn't quite long enough to fit around the jar, so that's why "YUM!" is continued on the next line down. So you want to cut out all of the top piece and a third of the "YUM" one. (enough to be able to overlap the two pieces) Glue and tape the two pieces together.
- As you can see, I allowed a bit of a margin on each side of the double lines. I just like that look, but you can cut right on the double line if you prefer.
- I wanted more definition and just more to the band, so I added a black band that's about 3 inches wide by about 13 or 14 inches long.
- To change any of the text, just highlight the word(s) you want to change, and type your own!



- The best way to cut these (and the bands above) lengthwise is with a paper slicer. If you one don't have and can "eyeball" it, go for it. Otherwise draw some lines between the labels with to cut on.
- I have spaced the labels so that you can just cut exactly between the labels and not have to make extra cuts.
- Cut the 6 labels on the right side pretty close (maybe 1/2 inch) to the left of the first words to allow enough room to make the banner edge. (See picture. >>>)
- To make the banner edge, just snip in to the center from the outside edges.



CIRCLE NAME TAGS



The size and width of the text will depend on the size of punch you have, and the length of the name(s) you are doing. So this will take some experimenting. Here are a few different font sizes for you to put your own names into ~ which you do by highlighting the name, and then typing the name you want. Don't delete and then type your name or the formatting will be lost. (You are welcome to use another font that you like better!) So just cut these out right down the middle between the "names," and then punch with whatever punches you have on hand. As you can see, I used two punches of different sizes and gave it a black border. I punched a hole in the two at the top and tied the tag on with raffia.
