179 CONSIDER REQUEST TO SUPPORT INSTALLATION OF STONE SNAKE ON LAND AT COLONELS LANE

Ben Harris and Aimee Havens attended the meeting to ask for support from the Parish Council for the proposed installation in the Parish of the stone snake which has been made by local residents during lockdown. The proposed site is where the snake is currently located at the junction of Wheatsheaf Close and Colonels Lane. Aimee is willing to set up a fundraising web-page so that the community can donate towards the cost of materials for the project. Ben has agreed to undertake the installation.

Sharron Davin at Kent County Council has agreed that the installation can take place on the Kent County Council owned land, subject to agreement with the Parish Council. Those present at the meeting discussed the proposal and were very happy to support the project. The Parish Council agreed to take responsibility for the public liability insurance for the installation.

The Parish Council, along with Cllr A. Gould and Cllr A. Bowles agreed to provide funding for the project if needed. The Parish Council agreed to fund a commemorative plaque to be located alongside the installation.
