**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

To allow tree surgery works to be carried out to hang over head fibre, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of South Street, Boughton Under Blean.

A closure is planned from 1st June 2020, between the hours of 09:30 and 17:00, with estimated completion by 12th June 2020, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC111WAQM4E5A004 - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [one.network](#)

South Street will be closed between the junctions with Nine Ash Lane and Kit Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while tree surgery works to hang over head fibre are undertaken by BT.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via South Street, Brenley Lane, Brenley Corner, A2 M2 J7 Roundabout, A2 Boughton Bypass, Canterbury Road, Stockers Hill, The Street, Horselees Road, Colonels Lane, Hickmans Green and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
