Dear Parents and Caregivers

The Board of Trustees cannot provide teaching for students during the upcoming strike.

The NZEI has advised the Cromwell Primary School Board of Trustees that the Principal, Wendy Brooks and teachers at our school will be taking strike action on Thursday 15th November from 7am to 7pm, as part of rolling strikes taking place across the country.

The Board has carefully considered the availability of teaching staff, and unfortunately decided that we cannot provide the normal teaching services during the strike. It is important that you can make alternative arrangements for the care of your child/children on the day of the strike. Please note that after school care will not be available on this day.

All teachers and the principal are on strike, so no supervision can be provided. The school will need to close during this strike. I know that this is inconvenient for parents and students alike, but please be assured that student safety is our main concern.
