

CROMWELL SCHOOL ENROLMENT SCHEME

Home zone

All students who live within the home zone described below (and *shown on the attached map*) shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

The home zone includes both sides of the road, unless specified:

- The area just south of Queensbury bounded by Luggate-Cromwell Road (SH6) to the west and the Clutha River to the east, from #2410 Luggate-Cromwell Road south to the intersection with State Highway 8B.
- Turn left into State Highway 8B and then left into Barry Ave (east side only).
- South along Barry Ave (east side only) to Bannockburn Rd.
- South along Bannockburn Rd to the Kawarau River.
- West along Kawarau River to the Nevis River. Follow the Nevis River south to Lower Nevis (up to and including #2502 Nevis Rd).
- Head back along Nevis Rd from #2502 to the intersection with Bannockburn Rd.
- Hawksburn Rd from the intersection with Bannockburn and Nevis Roads to #990.
- North along Bannockburn Rd from the intersection with Nevis Rd and Hawksburn Rd to Cairnmuir Rd, to include all of Cairnmuir Rd.
- Along SH8B from the intersection with Barry Ave and across the bridge to SH8.
- Tarras-Cromwell Rd (SH8) from the bridge north to #1161 Tarras-Cromwell Rd.
- Cromwell-Clyde Rd (SH8) from the bridge south to #2050 Cromwell-Clyde Rd.

Proof of residence within the home zone may be required.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Out of zone enrolments

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.


Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

- **First Priority:** *This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary.*
- **Second priority** must be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
- **Third priority** must be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
- **Fourth priority** must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

- **Fifth priority** must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.
- **Sixth priority** must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
