Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like to thank you all for your support and cooperation over the last couple of weeks. The children are showing great resilience getting used to the 'new normal' in school. The children are all settled and enjoying their learning in each year group.

From next week, the Academy will be open as normal on Friday afternoon – please collect your children at the same time as the rest of the week. Please can you ensure that social distancing is maintained, wherever possible, when you are dropping off and collecting children from the Academy. Once you have collected your children, exit the school gates promptly so that congestion at the exit is minimised.

Many children, including my own, are now getting coughs, colds and seasonal viruses. If your child has a cold, without a temperature, they can continue to attend school, if they are feeling well enough to do so. However, if you are concerned that they have a temperature or a persistent cough, please keep them off school and contact your GP, call 111 or 119 (Covid-19 helpline) If you are at all concerned, please contact the Academy and we can further advise. We must work together to ensure that we protect everyone, including those who are vulnerable in our community.

If the Academy was to close due to a local lockdown or a year group bubble had a positive case of Covid-19 so a 14 day self-isolation needed to take place, remote learning would start immediately for the affected children.
