ADMISSIONS PROCESS

UCC Benefactors sponsor Admission Application fees on behalf of eligible Applicants.

The University works to provide eligible students 100 percent of their demonstrated financial need to attend USA - University Colleges through scholarships, loans and other forms of assistance.

In order to determine eligibility, complete and submit the [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#). USA - University College Center school code: ~@~.

Students must complete the FAFSA at the same time an application is made for admission into USA - University College Center.

Once admitted to the certificate program, and the FAFSA has been completed and submitted, students will be sent an email with information about your financial aid award.

If you are enrolled in a Pre-Apprenticeship Training Certificate Program, you may be eligible for the Federal Pell Grant. The information on the FAFSA will determine your eligibility..

Students who are eligible for federal financial aid are awarded federal loans in amounts ranging from \$5,500 to \$12,500, depending on the information you provide on the FAFSA and the program of study for which the you are eligible to enroll, register, and actively participate. .
