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# A Brief History of Aquatic Sport In Malta

- Our swimming pools have been built during the past 17 years
- The most popular aquatic sport with the ASA of Malta is Water Polo. There were several sea water pitches around the island.
- Swimming is the second popular.
- There are is no diving or synchronised swimming clubs or coaches yet.



# Water Polo

- There are 9 water polo clubs in Malta and most of them have the junior teams as well. However there are no female teams, although a few female ex-water polo players in summers organise friendly matches.

# Swimming

There are 5 swimming clubs

- Swimmers Under 10 years of age:  
62, 29(46%) of whom are females
- Swimmers over 10 years of age:  
126, 65 (52%) of whom are females



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# Masters and Open Sea Swimming

- Masters Swimmers  
71, 29 (40%) of whom are females
- Open Sea Swimmers  
104, 27 (26%) of whom are females



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# Leadership Posts

- Swimming Coaches:  
22, 7 (32%) of whom are females
- Administrative posts:  
41, 5 (12%) of whom are females



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
