



# **Comment: Council Work Plan 2014-2017 Remarks of ENGSO**

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## Council Work Plan 2011-2014

- Recognised the societal role of sport but e.g. no discussion on volunteering, social inclusion, participation etc.
- Expert Groups finalised the planned deliverables
- Involvement of observers from sport movement in the Expert Groups brought some added value (ENGSO has been an observer in 4 out of 6 groups)
- Expertise of Member States varied in the groups
- Structured dialogue lunches in the context of Sport Minister Council meeting should be improved

## Council Work Plan 2014-2017

- In general ENGSO is pleased with the new Work Plan
- Themes: “Integrity of Sport”, “Economic Dimension of Sport” and “Sport and Society”
- Integrity of Sport: Topics Good Governance and Match-fixing will both have own Expert Group (XG)
  - GG: protect young athletes and safeguard children's rights in sport
  - Gender equality
- XG Economic Dimension of Sport:
  - Economic benefits of sport
  - Legacy of major sport events
  - Sustainable financing of sport

## Council Work Plan 2014-2017

- Two Expert Groups on “Sport and Society”
- XG on HEPA (health-enhancing physical activity)
  - HEPA and the implementation of the recommendations
  - Physical education in schools
- XG “Human Resource Management in Sport”:
  - Volunteering
  - Contribution of sport to the employability of young people
  - Dual careers
