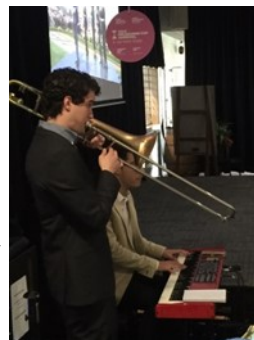
Twilight Jazz at the Club

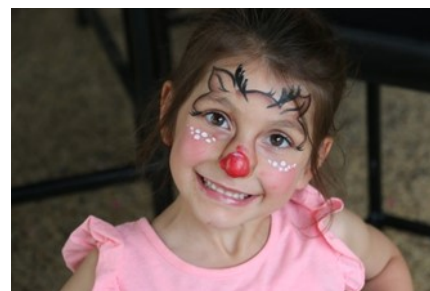
some glitter, Seaspray catering provided snacks for the children Jane blew up balls and Tina preparing the lolly bags.

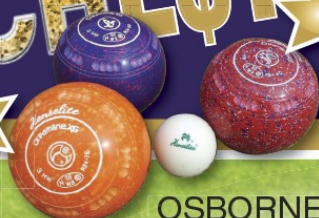
