National Point in Time "PIT" Homelessness Counts


- Brazil (2007),

- Puerto Rico (Every 2 years from 2005-2017), Uruguay (2011 & 2016).

Province or City PIT

- Argentina-Buenos Aires (April 2017)
- Brazil-Fortaleza & Sao Paulo (2002 & 2015)
- Colombia-Bogota (1997, 1999, 2001, 2004, 2007, 2011)
- Cali (2005) & Medellin (2002, 2009 & 2014)
- Nicaragua -León (1st PIT Central America March, 2017).

Does not have Homelessness counts


