During the annual seminar held in Dalian, China, in May 2015, the PHG executive committee approved unanimously a motion selecting Paris as the host of the 2018 annual seminar. In doing so, the French capital is following Nairobi (Kenya, 2016) and London (United Kingdom, 2017). This choice of Paris to welcome this annual seminar positions France as prime representative of the whole of Europe.

Organized in collaboration with all the principal players in the French healthcare system, this 38th seminar will take place in parallel with the Paris Healthcare Week and is co-organized with the editor of the magazine *Architecture Hospitalière*. The Working Group brings the experience and the know-how of the most seasoned professionals in the healthcare field during these seminars held every year in a different city around the world.



The working group dedicated to public health is part of the International Union of Architects (UIA). It was established in 1955 and composed of members and guests coming from more than 60 countries. Official representatives are architects in private practice and from academia. Their task is to advise world organizations on planning and design of healthcare projects and to participate in the development of guidelines. They take part also in research projects within the World Health Organization on healthcare models and bring their reflection on problems encountered by countries hosting the annual seminar.
