Applicants must:

- ✓ Have been a participant in a Columbia Urban League program.
- ✓ Have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00 to be eligible.
- ✓ Be accepted by an accredited college or university at the time of the scholarship award.
- ✓ **Meet financial need requirement.**

Applicants must submit the following:

- ✓ An official high school transcript
- ✓ A copy of SAT and/or ACT scores
- ✓ Documentation of involvement in community activities and service projects
- ✓ Copy of household's 2018 income tax return or FAFSA
- ✓ Recent photograph
- ✓ Copy of college or university acceptance letter
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation
- ✓ 375 word essay
