Relax in a casual tropical cafe and experience the taste of the island. Hemingway's Island Grill offer a diverse menu inspired by Hemingway's thirst for adventure and great food. Each dish is hand-crafted and delivers a taste of the islands. You have the option of dining inside or outside with amazing views of the bay. They have 2 outside decks overlooking the bay. As well as an inside & outside bar. A must to try is the **Mojito**, it's a refreshing blend of mint, lime, cane sugar and Bacardi rum. **Jack's Hurricane shrimp** is their top appetizer, Six char-grilled Shrimp brushed with Hemingway's Dark Rum sauce. Served with Island salsa and garlic bread. Ask your server about the fish selection, the **Trigger fish** is very flavorful, choose **Oscar Style**: it comes with Lump Crab meat and asparagus spears, drizzled with Hollandaise sauce served over Island rice.



At each Hemingway restaurant there exists a dining environment that Hemingway himself would have felt at home in. Exotic decor, a welcoming atmosphere, and a robust menu all reflect the Hemingway taste for adventure and good food, inspired by his worldly travels.
