The basic functionality is similar to that of a 360 virtual tour of an open house. With access directly from google street view, the user can navigate thru your business at their leisure. Business360 also links to your website directly and then uses a "click and move" type of "walking tour" of your business. The "dollhouse views" can showcase the details of your space while providing specifics of all you have to offer.
- Opening the doors virtually builds trust and relationships with potential customers and allows the user to "walk through" your space, view products, and get a feel for the atmosphere, all from the comfort of their own home.
