**Caring Together Program + Mothers in Charge
Working Together for Women (WTW)**

Women face many challenges and barriers after leaving jail or prison. Working Together for Women is a special recovery focused treatment program for women who have struggled with alcohol and/or drugs in the past and are now returning to the community.

Our team of health care professionals, including physicians, nurses, social service specialists, and addiction and mental health professionals work together to meet each woman's needs. Case managers and peer specialists meet with women while they are still in jail or prison to plan for their discharge housing, income, addiction, physical health, mental health, education, childcare and employment concerns and needs.

Once discharged, our team coordinates care and supports women in keeping appointments with medical, addiction and psychiatric treatment and social service professionals.
