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If you have Spanish speaking female participants that are receiving treatment at your facility for issues with substance use disorder and are in need of temporary, sober housing (up to 6 months), we are happy to announce that there is a Spanish women's recovery house!

The house is **completely renovated/remodeled** and **has 12 beds**. Additionally, for those participants that do not have a source of income, **their stay at the house is paid for through OAS** meals are also provided (residents will contribute to meals via their food stamps).

This is an opportunity for your participants to:

- Have a safe, sober place to live while working on their recovery
- Live in a home with other people who are supportive of their recovery and have similar goals.
- Be given the time needed to get stabilized mentally, emotionally and physically

To obtain a bed at the house, you will need the following:

- Requests must be made by referrals from the therapists at either inpatient, IOP, or OP
- Participants must either be Spanish speaking, Spanish dominant or bilingual. If participants do not speak or understand Spanish, they would be referred to an English-speaking recovery house that will better meet their language and recovery needs.
- In order to remain in the house, the residents will need to continue attending drug/alcohol treatment at their clinic, and also provide regular proof of negative drug screens from their clinics.
- Residents will also be expected to participate in NA/AA meetings (both outside and within the house).
