Plan early, especially if permits for special events, parks use, or street closures are necessary.

- If the event will be held at a city park, contact the Special Park Use Unit for information and rules at: (408) 794-6500 or <u>SPUapplication@sanjoseca.gov</u> Park permit applications must be submitted by Thursday, July 26th.
- If you are planning to close your street for a block party, you must obtain a Street Closure Application from the San Jose Police Department Permits Unit at: <u>http://www.sjpd.org/PDF Forms/</u>

BlkPartyInst-App.pdf. Street closure applications must be submitted and approved by Friday, July 27th.

 If your event is open to the general public and food will be served, contact the Health Department regarding Special Event and Health Permits: (408) 918-3400 or <u>https://www.sccgov.org/sites/cpd</u> /programs/TE/Pages/home.aspx. The Health Department applications

must be submitted by Tuesday, July 24th. However for qualification review for permit exemptions application must be submitted by Tuesday, July 17th.
