If you are one of our longtime QuickBooks users, you are familiar with Intuit's annual 'sunsetting' of QuickBooks. Typically, each fall Intuit releases a new version of QuickBooks, and the following spring, they discontinue support for older versions.

As of May 31, Intuit will stop supporting the 2014 versions of QuickBooks.

The Versions That Will No Longer Be Supported Include:

- QuickBooks Pro 2014
- QuickBooks Premier 2014 (General Business, Contractor, Manufacturing & Wholesale, Nonprofit, Professional Services, and Retail)
- QuickBooks Accountant 2014
- QuickBooks Enterprise 14.0 (General Business, Contractor, Manufacturing & Wholesale, Nonprofit, Professional Services, and Retail)
- QuickBooks Point of Sale v10 (already unsupported)
- QuickBooks for Mac 2012 (already unsupported)



WHAT DOES THIS MEAN



Any add-on services that you use with QuickBooks will no longer work (things like Payroll, Online Banking, Online Backup, etc.) If you do not use any of the add-on services listed, your software will continue to work fine but **you will not have access to Intuit's live technical support.**

Fortunately, Intuit does not charge missed version fees like most other companies do. However, we still recommend that you upgrade about every three years. We feel that this is a best practice and this also diminishes the risk of data damage and being in an emergency rather than planned upgrade situation.

It is always a balancing act with changing technology, and Intuit must apply their resources to future development and improvements with QuickBooks, rather than continuing support for older versions.



WHAT VERSION ARE YOU ON



QB Pro/Premier/Enterprise:

Not sure which version of QuickBooks you currently have? While in your company file, simply hit the F2 button on your keyboard. A window will appear telling you which QuickBooks product you are using as well as the year/version. If you are using a 2014 or older version, it is time to upgrade!

QB POS:

While in your company file, simply click on the Help button. Then click About Point of Sale at the bottom of the menu. A window will appear telling you which POS version you are using. If your version is 10.0 or older, it is time to upgrade!
