FORMATION \rightarrow grow in Christlikeness through learning and practice.

- Residents are invited to explore personal and communal spiritual practices.
- Build a curriculum (collaboratively, with input from The Possibility Project staff) to support discipleship, leadership development, & spiritual growth.



$\mathsf{COMMUNITY} \to \mathsf{ENGAGE}$ in life together with committed partners in ministry.

- Residents live in an intentional Christian community home shaped by a cohort of peers.
- Supported by the pastoral staff of The Possibility Project and sharing in the extended TPP community with the South Bay residents.
- Minister and grow alongside colleagues across the NorCal district.
- Practice incarnational ministry and hospitality with neighbors in the East Bay.



INNOVATION \rightarrow A SEEDBED ENVIRONMENT ALLOWS FOR RISK AND CREATIVE OPPORTUNITY.

- Residents are offered space to develop new ministry endeavors and to learn from failed approaches.
- The East Bay offers fertile ground for exploring how the mission of the Church can take root in a context that is socially, culturally, and economically diverse.




FAITHFULNESS \rightarrow Pursue vocational calling within a committed church context.

- Hayward First Church of the Nazarene offers a congregational space for ministry and a faithful community that desires to see the gospel embodied.
- Efforts for innovation grow out of a commitment to the Church of the Nazarene's core mission and to the Kingdom of God.

$EMPOWERMENT \rightarrow LEADERS$ ARE ENCOURAGED AND EQUIPPED TO SERVE IN MINISTRY.

- Pastoral experience with guidance and support from ministry supervisors.
- Housing is provided in the Hayward parsonage.
- A focus on female clergy creates space for women to take leadership roles and offers support tailored to their experience.



- NorCal mentorship (Those seeking ordination will join the established mentorship program, paired with an individual pastor mentor.)
- Collaborative mentorship (Participants will cultivate networks of ministry partners in a relational and equitable approach.)
