WHO CAN ENTER?

The East Providence Historical Society invites any baking enthusiast to enter The Great Rumford Bake Off to be held on Sunday, May 12, 2019 during the Historical Society's Old-Fashioned Family Fun Day!

- **There are two divisions:** Adult (18 and older) and Junior Baker (ages 9 through 17), and both home bakers and professional bakers are eligible to enter. However, all baked goods must be made in a home kitchen.
- The deadline to register is May 1, 2019.

WHAT WILL I WIN?

The First Place winner in the Adult Division will win \$200 and a Great Rumford Bake Off trophy. The First Place winner in the Junior Division will win \$100 and a Great Rumford Bake Off trophy. The 2nd and 3rd place winners in each division will win a ribbon and gift card.

All entrants will receive a certificate for participating!

WHAT CAN I BAKE?

Participants may enter one baked item. Recipes must include Rumford Baking Powder. The following are the types of baked goods that will be accepted:

- **CAKES:** Baked cakes that may be single or multi-layer.
- **COOKIES/DESSERT BARS**
- **CAKE TYPE BREADS:** (i.e. Banana, Date, etc)
- **SCONES/DESSERT TYPE BISCUITS**
- **MUFFINS**

If you have a special dessert recipe that includes Rumford Baking Powder, but is not listed, please feel free to send further inquiries to mail@RumfordBakeOff.com

How Do I ENTER?

Entrants must pre-register in order to be eligible to participate. Please fill out the entry form on this sheet or by downloading an entry form at: RumfordBakeOff.com. Please contact mail@RumfordBakeOff.com with any event questions.

Registration is NOT ALLOWED on the day of the event!

Check-in is between 11:00am and 11:30am in the Bake Off tent located across from The Hunt House on the grounds of Hunt's Mill (65 Hunts Mill Road, East Providence, RI).

Participants may enter any recipe that is special to them! Recipes do not need to be original. Recipes may be an old family recipe or come from a cookbook, magazine, website or any other means.

- Submitted recipes must include Rumford Baking Powder.
- Please bring a copy of your recipe or an ingredient list with your baked submission.
- Submissions must be home cooked (NOT STORE BOUGHT)
- Please DO NOT submit anything that will easily spoil without refrigeration as the event is held outside.
- All entries are to be submitted as a whole (complete cake) or in a quantity of a half dozen or dozen.
- All entries will preferably be submitted on a paper or recyclable plate/container.

Should a participant wish to submit their entry on a non-recyclable plate/container, it is the responsibility of the entrant to pick up the container promptly following the announcement of the winners.

HOW WILL RECIPES BE JUDGED?

All entries must meet the requirements of the contest. Recipes not meeting contest entry criteria will be disqualified. Entries will be judged by the following criteria:

- Appearance (*maximum 10 points*)
- Taste (*maximum 10 points*)
- Creativity (*maximum 10 points*)

HOW WILL FINALISTS BE SELECTED?

A panel of judges will taste test all entries. Each judge will complete a judging sheet. A combined score will be calculated to indicate the final scoring placement.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I WIN?

Winners will be announced at 2:00pm or shortly after, and winners do not need to be present in order to win. However, we encourage entrants to be present so as to not miss out on photo opportunities taking place during and after the award ceremony.
