Doggie Day Care Policies and Procedures

Attendance:

- All thoroughly completed documentation is required before the dog will be accepted into Day Care
- All dogs being brought to Day Care are assumed healthy, but will be observed for illness, parasites, joint pain, etc. If a health concern is suspected, the owner will be notified and the dog will be kept out of play for the remainder of the day
- Day Care hours are from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. All dogs must be picked up by 6:00 pm or a late fee will be assessed (see pricing sheet for more information)
- No dogs will be welcome to attend Day Care within two weeks of vaccination
- Notification must be given prior to sending someone other than the specified owner(s) to pick up any dog

Evaluation:

- All potential candidates for Day Care will be subject to an evaluation
- Any indication of inappropriate aggression toward another dog or a staff member will not be tolerated and the dog will be dismissed from the Day Care program
- All dogs older than six months of age must attend Day Care at The Pet Campus, Inc. for four full days (not necessarily consecutive) to be thoroughly evaluated
- Applicants under the age of six months will be subject to a two full-day evaluation
- Applicants older than six months of age who have attended either Puppy Kindergarten or Taming the Teen at The Pet Campus, Inc. will be subject to a two full-day evaluation
- Each dog will have evaluation forms completed; one for each of the evaluation days. Copies of the evaluation forms will remain internal unless a copy is specifically requested by the owner
- After four full days of attendance the staff will make a final determination on the appropriateness of the dog and its acceptance into the program

Daily Activities:

- All Day Care dogs will receive a snack and a mandatory “nap time” (in a crate) during the day
- Staff educators will reinforce the following good manner behaviors with all dogs daily: “sit” — no jumping up on humans
- Staff educators will teach and reinforce the following good manner behaviors with all puppies (under six months old) daily: “sit” — “down” — “come” — “leave it” — “drop it” — no puppy biting and nipping — no jumping up on humans
- A maximum of eight dogs will comprise each play group
- All dogs in play groups will be supervised at all times

Play Related Injuries:

- Dogs play using their mouths and bodies. It is very likely that a bump, bruise, scrape or even minor laceration may occur during appropriate play with other dogs. Appropriate first aid will be administered if necessary
- Hard body slams and active contact between two dogs can result in serious injury. Should a dog get injured and require medical attention, the dog will be taken to the vet that is listed as that dog's medical practitioner
- If any dog is injured seriously and the Day Care staff believes the dog's injuries to be life threatening, the dog will be taken to the VSEC facility in Langhorne

Medical:

- Medical Requirements
 - Adults & Adolescent (older than 6 months)
 - Proof of current vaccination against rabies, distemper, adenovirus 2 and bordetella (kennel cough)
 - Negative fecal
 - Spay/Neuter
 - Puppies (less than 6 months)
 - At minimum: first two rounds of puppy shots
 - Negative fecal
- Day Care staff must be notified if a dog was ill and needed vet care within the past one month. Depending on the illness, The Pet Campus, Inc. reserves the right to excuse that dog from Day Care until a consultation with the dog's vet verifies the dog is healthy
- If a sick dog is brought to The Pet Campus, Inc. for Day Care and it is not identified during the intake exam, the owner is responsible for returning to pick up that dog within one hour of the notifying phone call. A quarantine fee of \$20 will be assessed to owners who do not promptly return for dogs that are ill
- All dogs over six months of age must be spayed or neutered
- Any adolescent or adult will have to forgo Day Care for two weeks after having vaccinations
- Any dog that receives a topical flea or tick treatment may not attend daycare for at least 3 days after application
