


Login with your current email address and password.

Make note of the different tabs (Messages, Settings, Policies, Status) and all the options with each tab.


Today we will focus on the "Messages" tab and the options with this tab such as "Release", and "Delete".




Releasing a email in your dashboard

Click message 1x to highlight email and select the "Release" button from the dashboard to remove it from your SPAM filter.


If you want to release all SPAM filter emails choose the "Select All" option. Then press the "Release" option.



Releasing an email message from Edgewave SPAM filter-confirmation window




All you have to do at this screen is click "Next"



Click the "Finish" button


Your email should appear in your inbox after it is released



If you want to remove the SPAM emails from the filter:


Click message 1x to highlight email and select the "Delete" button from the dashboard to remove it from your SPAM filter.

<u>Like before, if you want to delete all SPAM filter emails choose the "Select All" option. Then press the "Delete" option.</u>



After you do, it will ask for a confirmation

Click "OK" if you are sure you want to delete message.
