Contamination Reduction in Biological Material collection

As fire investigators, we work with Police Forensics all the time. The collection of evidence is their job, but it is our job to find that evidence and make recommendations about what is best to be collected. Reducing the risk of contaminating any evidence that fire investigators may be involved in is very important. This presentation by Sergeant Jane Josephs will explain the do's and don'ts of contamination.

Jane joined the NSW Police in 2005 after 20 years working in hospital sterilising units. She did 4 years at Harbourside LAC in general duties and licensing before joining FSG in 2010. She has worked at Chatswood and Sydney Crime Scene offices. She has completed an Advanced Diploma in Forensic Investigation in 2014, and has a Graduate Certificate - on the 'Propensity for Ignition of Old and New household electrical cable' in 2015. In 2016 she sat the Australasian Field Forensic Science Accreditation Board panel and was certified as an expert in the Methodology of Crime Scene Investigation. She was promoted to SGT in 2017. She completed the NSW Police Structural fire examination course in 2012 and the NSW Police wildfire examination course, and have examined over 60 fires.
